

Letter of invitation

(when the applicant is staying in a private address in Argentina, instead of a hotel)

- **Requirements:**
 - ✓ The invitation letter must be written in Spanish or duly translated into Spanish, and addressed to the Consulate.
 - ✓ Present the **ORIGINAL INVITATION LETTER**. The letter must be certified by a Public Notary in Argentina and by the Notary Association ("Colegio de Escribanos").
 - ✓ The invitation letter must include:
 - The personal details the person inviting (name, ID number, date of birth, nationality, and address in Argentina).
 - Name of the person requesting the visa (name, Passport number, date of birth, nationality).
 - Date of entry and exit of Argentina (the same as in the flight or bus ticket).
 - Day-to-day program itinerary of your trip.

NOTE: It is recommended to send attach the letter by email (zst@cancilleria.gov.ar) to this Consulate, FOR REVIEW BEFORE SEND TO LEGALIZE.
